

Skipton residents called to help plan town's future

Skipton locals are invited to meet Council's planning team and discuss the draft structure plan for the town.

There will be a drop-in session at the Mechanics Hall on Wednesday 24 April.

North Ward Councillor Nick Cole encouraged people to come along and talk about their hopes and aspirations for the town's future.

"It's your town so come and tell us what's important to you," he said.

"Last year Council reached out to the community with face-to-face meetings and an online survey. That gave us insights into the issues and opportunities facing the town, which have gone into this draft plan.

*Now we're asking for feedback before we finalise the plan for use in future planning decisions and investments. If you can't make the drop-in session, you can download the plan and leave your comments on the Council website."

The main issues raised by the community of Skipton included:

- Skipton's commercial sector is declining.
- The threat of major flooding is discouraging commercial and residential investment.
- The lack of public transport creates a barrier for resident mobility.
 Lack of tourist opportunities.
- Lack of employment opportunities.
- Lack of housing supply and availability.

Manager Planning and Building Services Aaron Moyne said Council was committed to supporting Skipton's future by creating development opportunities and providing clear direction on sustainable change.

"The key aim of the Skipton Structure Plan is to plan for and develop a shared vision for the town, including identifying the type and amount of land use change projected over the next 15-20 years. It aims to direct and promote residential growth, protect the Mt Emu creek environs, and plan for the growth of commercial, industrial and tourism opportunities."

Below is page 2 of 3 of documents help by Skipton Historical Society from "The Herald, Tuesday Jan 18th 1944" Titled "HOPE ALL THAT'S ALIVE IN DESOLATE WILLOWVALE" By R. K. Gerrand a Herald Special Representative on tour of the Western District.

A few miles south of Linton you plunge into the black country at Mannibadar. For miles you travel on and scarely see a house standing. An odd rare place untouched only accentuates the ruins of the rest and always it is hospitably over-filled with refugee families.

STILL CHEERFUL

These are cheerful cases. The people show astoundingly good spirits. You can't keep these Australians down.

They all say: "Don't forget to put in a word for the Red Cross, they're doing a great job for us".

On further is the Mount Bute soldier settlement - or used to be. I had been prepared for bad sights, knowing 40 homes had been destroyed 12 miles between Mt. Bute and Berrybanks, which is all gone - store, post office, banks, houses, everything - and 60 in the same distance between Bradvale and Lismore. But when you get in amoung it it is worse than you could imagine.

Mr. C.B. Roberts was catching a mare by the road between the ruins of Mt. Bute farmhouses when we pulled up beside him. Except that it's tail was half burnt off it was unhurt.

LOST 20 YEARS

"Well, we're all back where we were 20 years ago," he said, as he looked the mare over for burns she had escaped. "But we can thank God it's no worse. I was away in Melbourne in the Army my oldest boy is in the Airforce. My wife and the two kids got into the dam with two dogs and the kitten while the fire burnt all around".

Not far away Mrs. W. Hawkins and her two-year-old grandson were burnt to death.

I have had to come back to Willowvale the last post office left standing before Lismore, and the last telephone before a stretch of 15 miles completely burnt out.

Willowvale post office, in Mr. W. Hayward's farm home, was one of the miracles of the fire, which burnt nearly round it.

The place was saved by Ballarat Fire Brigade and has become a centre of communication for relief. On the wall by the telephone is an appeal by the Bush Fire Brigades' Association for help for the victims of the Wangaratta fire a few weeks ago.

The notice was put up one day before the district had its own fires. Now it is Willowvale's turn for help.



FIRE RESTRICTIONS TO END IN SOUTH-WEST

The Fire Danger Period (FDP) will finish at 1.00am on Monday, 22 April in the following municipalities in CFA's Districts 4,5, 6 and 7:

- City of Greater Geelong
- Borough of Queenscliffe
- Surf Coast Shire
- Golden Plains Shire
- Corangamite Shire
- Colac-Otway Shire
- · South Grampians Shire Council
- Moyne
- Warrnambool
- · Glenelg Shire

While restrictions are lifting in these areas, CFA still expects the grassfire risk to remain across the state so Victorians need to remain alert and prepared.

CFA Deputy Chief Officer of South-West Adrian Gutsche said conditions have changed significantly in the past several weeks and prompted an early finish to the fire danger period.

"We encourage people to exercise caution once restrictions are lifted.

"All burning off must be conducted in compliance with municipal local laws."

"There was real potential in the region for fires prior to this due to the late onset of summer, several high fire danger days and considerable drying of all available fuels.

"Communities have really played their part by being vigilant and understanding the risk to ensure there were no damaging fires that could have put us at risk" Adrian said.

"We're urging everyone to stay safe, whether you're living in or travelling to high bushfire risk areas.

"Please monitor the conditions on hot, dry and windy days, as we may still see some days of elevated fire risk."

The end of the Fire Danger Period (FDP) will be an opportunity for some landowners to burn-off again, however it's important that residents check that local conditions are safe before undertaking these activities.

"You must register your burn-offs, check weather conditions and follow local council laws and regulations," Adrian said.
